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3rd Grade Science

The 3rd grade students wrapped up their units on forces, magnetism, and electricity this quarter. First, students came into the HUB to work on a Junkyard-inspired design challenge. They had to construct their own electromagnet to test in a model junkyard filled with various items. Students collected points for the items that they were able to lift up and out of the junkyard bin.



They also had the opportunity to use special conductive modeling clay to explore how simple circuits work. Students were given a challenge card and had to construct different animals or objects out of the clay, then wire the circuit, add the light bulbs, and watch it glow!
