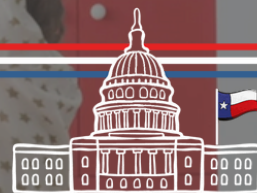
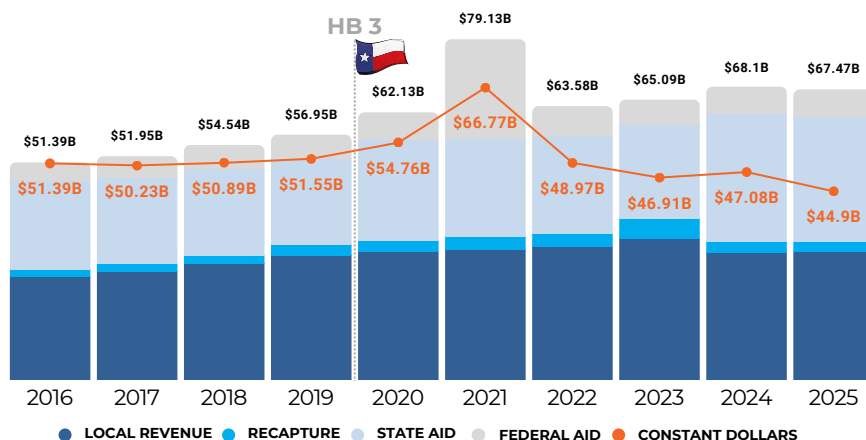

The **basic allotment** is the primary mechanism used to fund Texas public schools. Every increase in the basic allotment, triggers additional funding for **key programs** and **state priorities**.

\$4,630 AVERAGE TEACHER PAY RAISE

\$1.39M FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION

\$203K FOR SCHOOL SAFETY
