9th Grade

11th Grade

Minimum of 4 High School Classes

- Honors Math 3 or 4 or college math that satisfies NC 4th math graduation requirement*
- Honors English 3 or UNCG Course English 101*
- AP US History or Honors American History*
- Honors Chemistry*
- HHS 131 Pathways (3-credit UNCG course Spring semester)*
- Electives (UNCG courses or high school electives—at least 4; recommend general education requirements, math, science, and a global language)

12th Grade

Minimum of 1 High School Class

- Honors English 4 or UNCG English 104 or 105*
- Economics and Personal Finance*
- HHS 140 Pathways (3-credit UNCG course Fall semester)*
- Electives (UNCG courses and/or high school electives;
 Recommend general education requirements, math, science, and a global language)

Note: Students may take a total of 5 classes per semester. UNCG course enrollment is based on satisfactory completion of high school courses. UNCG courses are not available through GCS in the summer. UNCG courses are subject to availability.
