Weaver National Honor Society Criteria for Membership 2024-2025

The National Honor Society is an organization which recognizes outstanding achievement in the following 4 areas:

- 1. Scholarship
 - a. Invited Juniors the minimum is a weighted GPA of 4.3 due to the addition of AP Precalculus.
 - b. Invited Seniors the minimum is a weighted GPA of 4.1.
- 2. Leadership
- 3. Character
- 4. Service

Membership is an honor, not a privilege, and is based on a student's overall achievement in these 4 areas. The GPA alone does not guarantee membership.

A student MUST have been enrolled at Weaver Academy, as a PVA student, for at least **one semester** before he/she is eligible for membership in NHS. A student must be a member of the junior or senior class. The application must be completed online.

A completed application packet will include:

- a) Application
- b) NHS Essay Prompt
- c) Teacher recommendation forms from your 2024 Spring Semester teachers

In addition to GPA, the students will be reviewed in the following three areas by the Faculty Council.

- Character, Leadership and Service
 - Leadership- A student with 10+ points on the Student Activities portion of the application will move forward in the selection process.
 - o Service will be reviewed based on the Service Opportunities listed on the application.
 - o The NHS essay will serve as the Character assessment in addition to Teacher Recommendations.
- The review of NHS application by the Faculty Council is done anonymously. Student names will be redacted from the applications before the Faculty Council sees them.

Weaver Academy has one induction ceremony per year in the Fall Semester.
