Critical Points to Service-Learning


- Definition: A way of teaching and learning that connects positive and meaningful action in the community with academic learning, personal growth and civic responsibility.
- Service-Learning helps develop citizenship and good character while providing direct connections to the academic curriculum. Service-Learning experiences allow students to apply their social and emotional skills into action.

Objectives

- Understand how to plan and execute a successful donation drive.
- Learn the do's and don't's for engaging students meaningfully.



What Counts for Service-Learning hours?



- Students earn hours through active participation in planning and execution.
- Examples:
 - Organizing the drive
 - Promoting the event
 - Collecting and sorting donations

Do's for Donation Drives



- Involve students in the planning process.
- Set clear roles and responsibilities.
- Promote the drive through social media and school announcements.
- Create a drop-off hub in a convenient location.
- Track and report hours accurately.

Don'ts for Donation Drives

- Don't allow students to claim hours for just donating items.
- Don't let the drive become disorganized; maintain a clear schedule.
- Don't forget to thank donors and volunteers.
- Don't limit participation to just one group; encourage all students to join.



Planning Process Example



Form a committee: Include students and coaches.



Set goals: Decide on the number of items to collect.



Create a timeline: Schedule planning meetings and the drive dates.



Promote the drive: Use posters, announcements, and social media.



Collect items: Set up the drop-off hub.



Sort and deliver: Organize donations for distribution.

Engaging the Community

- Host events to raise awareness.
- Involve local media for promotion.
