- Annual meeting: Our annual meeting will occur in August in the auditorium.
- Involve parents in the development of PFE plan and the Title I program: Our PTSA and our Arts Booster Club will be important in assisting with the inclusion of parents and families. The Board members of both organizations are included in the PFE planning process.
- Provide information to parents: Penn-Griffin will provide timely information to parents and families through the use of letters delivered home, Canvas announcements and correspondence, weekly connect ed messages, and the use of the school, PTSA, and Booster club social media outlets.
