(HC) 25. Student Disenrollment

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Schools (“Superintendent”) has requested that the Mountain Lakes Board of Education (the “Board”) disenroll a student (“Student”), whose name is on file in the Board Office, based upon information that the Student is not entitled to a tuition-free education from the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent provided the Student’s parents notice of their right to a disenrollment hearing in the event that they did not agree with the Superintendent’s determination;

WHEREAS, the Student’s parents did not request a hearing;

WHEREAS, the Board considered the evidence presented by the administration in support of the Superintendent’s recommendation to disenroll the Student; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the Student is not entitled to a tuition-free education from the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Student shall be disenrolled from the Mountain Lakes School District, effective 21 days from the notice of disenrollment, and the Board Secretary shall provide the parents with notice of the disenrollment decision; provided, however, that if the Student's parent contest the Board's decision before the Commissioner of Education within 21 days of the notice of disenrollment, then the Student shall remain enrolled in the Mountain Lakes School District while the appeal is pending before the Commissioner of Education, subject to the right of the Board to collect tuition in the event that the parents are unsuccessful in their appeal or withdraw their appeal, as recommended by the Superintendent.
