

## BMS Frequently Used Apps -Available on the Dashboard



### **Edpuzzle**

Edpuzzle allows teachers to create interactive video lessons where students will have to answer questions to progress through the video.



### **GradeCam**

GradeCam is a testing platform where teachers create multiple-choice assignments to be graded electronically. Students may log into GradeCam after a test to see results.



### **OER**

OER: Online Educational Resources: WCS created online textbooks and student resources. CK-12 is the textbook accessed through the OER.



### **Edulastic**

Edulastic is an educational assessment platform where students can get immediate feedback on assignments. Many assignments are available for students to review their results.



### **Kami**

Kami is an online document annotation and markup tool. Students can add text, highlights, underline, or shapes to a PDF or other document. Students can turn in assignments directly from Kami. Kami also has a read aloud function.



### **Performance Matters**

Performance Matters is a testing platform where students take Benchmarks (district created tests at the end of the nine weeks) and CFA (common formative assignments) created by teachers to monitor student mastery of standards. In the Student Portal, all test results are visible, and many tests are available to review student results question by question.



### **SkyWard**

SkyWard is our School Management Software where schedules and grades are posted. You also have access to your student's username and password to get to their Schoology. Click on a grade to see the individual assignments.



### **Securly**

Securly allows teachers and administrators to monitor students using district Chromebooks, laptops and desktop computers. (Not visible on students' dashboard)



### **Flextime Manager (FLEX)**

Flextime Manager is an app used by students to select a 3rd period Thrive session (class) to attend.



### **Schoology**

Schoology is the Learning Management System used in grades K-12. Each class has their own page where students can access assignments and resources. Students have a calendar at the top of the page to monitor when assignments are due. It also has a messaging program for students to contact their teachers.



### **SAVVAS**

ELA online textbook and assessment platform. (ELA benchmarks are done on this platform)



### **McGraw-Hill**

McGraw-Hill is the current math adoption for textbooks. Part of the adoption is ALEKS, an adaptive learning program. Math teachers can add their own assignments in ALEKS. ALEKS also has a Pie feature that efficiently identify the exact topics each individual student has mastered, and which ones they are ready to learn, based on their answers to a small number of questions.
