### **UPDATE**

In December, Alameda Unified School District (AUSD) informed you about pile driving at Wood Middle School, 420 Grand Street, scheduled from mid-January through mid-March. You may have noticed a four-week pause starting in late January—we hope this provided some relief from any disruption. This break was due to an unforeseen site condition, which has now been resolved.

As a result, pile driving will resume and continue through mid-April.

Pile driving will cause a noise disturbance during construction hours. The entire construction project is expected to be completed in time for the 2026-2027 school year.

This complete rebuilding of the Wood campus will include:

- A new two-story classroom building, administration/library building, and gymnasium
- Removal of the current primary classroom building
- New landscaping, including green spaces
- A new access road connecting Otis Drive to Grand Street
