VI. Presentation (Ex: Data, Budget, Programs)

1. Title 1 Parent Training - Sima Gandhi

Sima Gandhi is from the District Office. Ensures schools follow accountability practices.

OHS is required by law to offer a TItle I training to all parents, staff and students. Public training. Ensures that Title I funds are being used to serve the students who need to be served, and that funds are being used appropriately.

Gandhi started by providing an overview of what TItle I is. She also shared CAASP scores. ELA scores are good for unduplicated students (socioeconomically disadvantaged, foster youth, homeless, English learners, students with disabilities, long-term English learners). Suggests that Title I dollars are being used to support students appropriately. Math and science scores are a growth area. However, this is a growth area for many high schools across California, not just Oakmont. Likely partly due to Covid disruptions.

Gandhi shared how Title I funds are being used at Oakmont:

- Intervention
- ELD instruction
- Professional development for teachers
- Staff time
- Technology
- School spirit gear
- IB tests

Shared that parents have the right to attend meetings (e.g., SSC), ask questions of how funding is being used. OHS is required to have Parent and Family Engagement Policy, this was recently approved by the board and will be in the handbook next year.

1. Information: World Language (Russian 1) Course Review

Proposed at Antelope and Roseville. Similar to other foreign language classes in the district.

2. Information: Revised Cell PhoneBoard Policy

CA state policy requires that all schools have a cell phone policy. Changes in the document highlighted in red.

3. SPSA Revisions - Updated to reflect current CBEDS budget revisions. <u>SPSA Changes</u> and Current SPSA

Major changes:

- Health Academy: updated grant funding from State
- Dual Enrollment: money used to purchase DE sections, at least through 2026-27
- General fund: carryover posted from 23-24
- LCAP tutoring: District gave an additional 2k because we are Title I, used to help pay staff who are helping with tutoring
- Changes in TItle I and Prop 28 funds due to updated CBEDS
