



High School Scheduling FAQs for 2025-26 School Year

Q: What time does school start and end?

A: The school day runs from 7:45 a.m.-2:40 p.m. Here is the [2024-2025 Bell Schedule](#).

Q: What is an A Day and B Day?

A: An A day runs hours 1, 3, 5, 7 and a B day runs hours 2, 4, 6, 8

Q: When does my student get their high school schedule?

A: Scheduling and registration will be in August and the district will notify parents of the specific dates in the summer.

Q: How does my student take Health and/or Phys. Ed in the summer?

A: BHHS offers both Health and P.E. in the summer, registration will be available to families in April. These courses will count toward the graduation requirement.

Q: What are the core academic courses required in 9th grade?

A: All students will take a math, English, science and social studies class along with an Interdisciplinary Class. See the [Course Description Book](#) for more details

Q: How are students assigned to Learning Communities?

A: Students are assigned LCs at random. Personalized scheduling requests for teachers or Learning Communities are not able to be honored. All scheduling is completed at random by the computer to allow for equitable and balanced schedules.

Q: What does my student need to graduate?

Q: What is the IB Diploma Programme?

A: This program is a grade 11 and 12 comprehensive program that incorporates 6 content areas as well as additional requirements: the Theory of Knowledge, the extended essay, and service experiences.
