
BACKGROUND:

The Oakdale Joint Unified School District, under Education Codes 41850.1 and 38900, shall annually collect and publish transportation data from each local educational agency providing pupil transportation services and that receives an apportionment under this section. The data shall encompass ridership, miles driven, fuel types, expenditure details, the number of pupils transported, the demographic characteristics of pupils transported, and other data facilitating comparison among local educational agencies.


ANALYSIS:

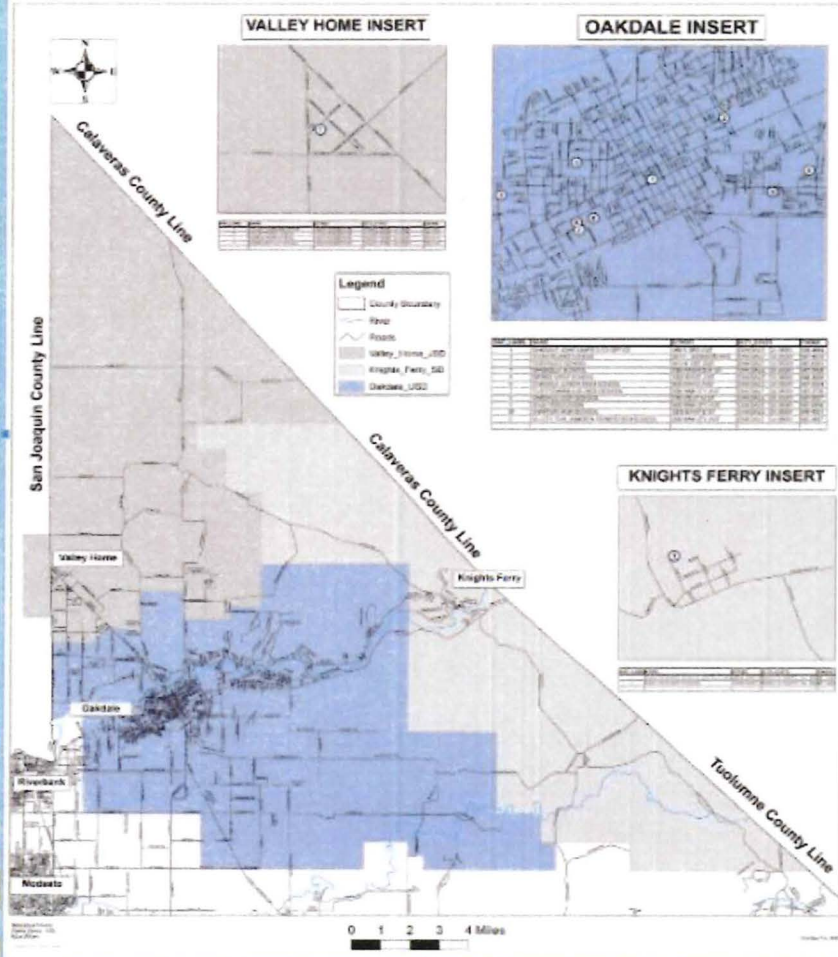

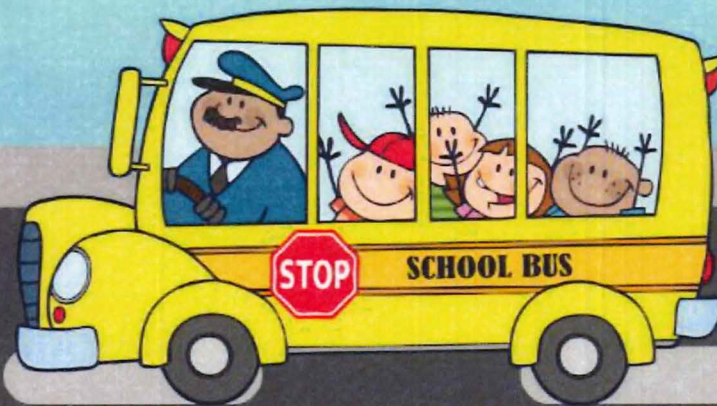

10/22 Have Lap/shoulder belts**



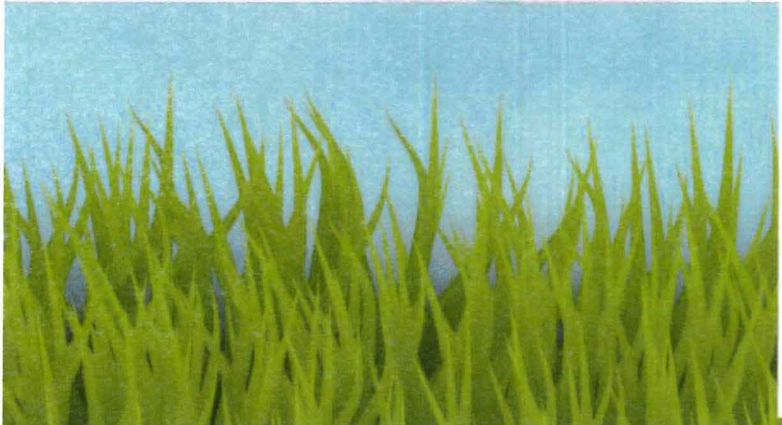
**GASOLINE 1

Good afternoon, Mustang Mover Families. Due to ongoing road construction at the intersection of 3rd and H Streets in Oakdale, the bus stop previously located near the Taco Truck will be temporarily relocated to the intersection of 3rd and I Streets. This change is effective today, February 26, 2025, and will remain in place until further notice. This adjustment aims to ensure safe and efficient pick-up and drop-off services during the construction period. We appreciate your understanding and patience as Oakdale works to improve local infrastructures.

A Transformative Change in Transportation Communication

Significant Reduction in Phone Calls

Parents receive precise updates about bus locations and changes.

Riders are informed about delays and alternate bus stops in seconds.

Reduced administrative workload for the transportation team.

Encourage more families to engage with the platform for better results.

- **Identify areas with the highest number of unduplicated students in TK-6**
 - **1,172 students here at Oakdale fall in one or more of the Ed Code categories**
- **Pay back the funds used to purchase six new buses with HTS reimbursement.**
- **Start with approximately 8 Gen Ed and 6 SpEd bus routes with consideration of available Bus Drivers and Bus Aides**
- **Future plan is flexible, with a goal to service middle & high schools eventually. TK-8 grade students will be eligible for shuttle stops**
