1. Informational Item: Superintendent Advisory Council Update

- There was a dinner on the 28th and they celebrated Teachers and Professionals of the Year

2. Discussion Item: Principal's Update/Strategic Plan Progress Report

- COSA – Change of School Assignments Hopewell 13 students applied to attend who are out of district. This process has changed teacher allotments and budget expectations.

Strategic Plan update:



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- Reading at or above grade level - The annual growth of the median of our students is at 117% the typical annual growth goal.
- Decrease total referrals by 10% - currently we are at 103 behavior incidents documented so far this year. We had 280 last year and our goal was to be
- ESOL Proficiency in Reading – ESOL department is currently in the middle of ACCESS testing.
- Employee and Parent/Guardaian satisfaction – no data right now
- Spend all charter dollars - We are expected to meet this goal.

Benchmarks

- Based on unit assessments in ela, math and 8th grade science and social studies. Data looks good and there has been significant growth.
- About 1/3 of student population has met goal and about 1/3 is above math goal.

Additional Updates

- Marquee was turned on yesterday.
- Chicken coop was delivered last Friday – There will be a security fence put up before chickens are put in the coop to keep animals and people from having access to the chickens. Ms. Withrow is doing a great job with the agriculture program and we're hoping to have a greenhouse in the future.
- Hoops for Heart is tomorrow. Our school typically does a great job of raising money through this event.
- Course recommendations and schedules for next year are being finalized.
- High school visits were yesterday to Alpharetta and Cambridge. There was great feedback from these visits.
- Our rising 6th grade visits and parent nights are coming up soon for our 5 feeder schools – Summit Hill, Cogburn, Manning Oaks, Birmingham Falls
