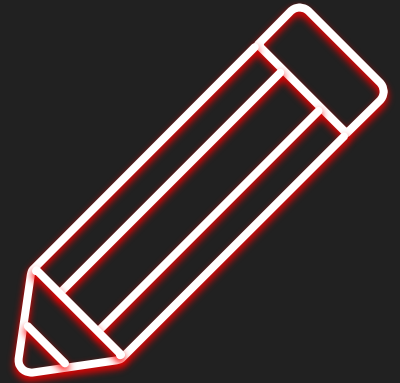

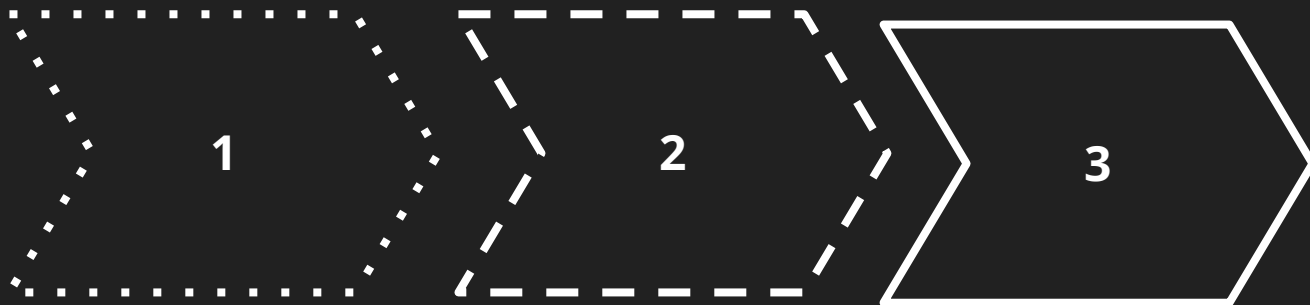

AGE REQUIREMENTS

Students must be 5 years old by August 1, 2025,
to enroll.

EARLY ENTRANCE PROCESS

- Meeting with principal
- Referral
- Individual IQ assessment
- Achievement testing in reading and math
- Social/emotional rating scales
- Preschool observation
- Team meeting

What to expect from today's kindergarten...

ALL DAY KINDERGARTEN

Academics

- 90 minutes of reading instruction daily
- 60 minutes of mathematics instruction daily
- Science and social studies integrated into reading and math instruction

Specials

- S.T.E.M.

Routines

- Lunch (30 min.)
- Recess (30 min.)
- Snack

Kindergarten Class

- Class size (18-26)
- 4 teachers per grade level in both buildings (K-4)

- Bus cameras
- Exit alarms on exit doors.
- Nurse on staff

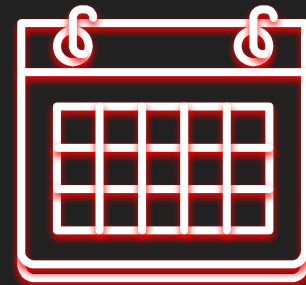
Drills

- August 20, 2025, first day K-5

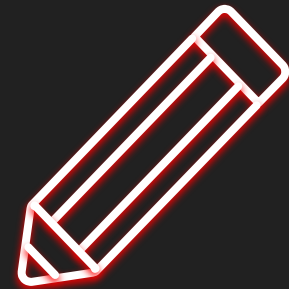


KINDERGARTEN READINESS ASSESSMENT (KRA)

Statewide assessment administered during the first two months of school.

Measures the following skills:

- Social skills
- Language and literacy
- Mathematics
- Science
- Social Studies
- Physical well-being
- Motor development
