OPEN CAMPUS POLICY FOR SENIORS

As many seniors are of an age when society confers adult responsibility upon them and many will be entering jobs and attending post-secondary institutes where individual responsibility will be placed upon them, it is therefore necessary that they learn to cope with these responsibilities in a mature fashion. The purpose of open campus is to extend to seniors an opportunity to learn to plan their time and determine if the individual can maturely meet their obligations to the school.

RULES

1. Students who have received any D, F, I or U on their third quarter report cards or on the fourth quarter mid-quarters will not be eligible for open campus. Third quarter grade deficiencies will be reevaluated at the mid-quarter of the fourth quarter. This will be the only reevaluation. Students must maintain a cumulative GPA of 1.75 or better.
2. Any student who has any unexcused absences, Saturday School, or receives a detention during the third or fourth quarter will not be eligible for or will lose their open campus privileges.
3. Students who are on open campus shall not be roaming the halls of the school.
4. Any organized skip day will result in immediate cancellation of open campus.
5. Any students who are found in possession or use chemical substances will have open campus privileges canceled, as is stated in the student conduct/policy book.
6. No smoking on school grounds or within the school zone, as defined as one block within school property line, even if the student is 18.
7. Any students who are on open campus and are reported breaking any driving laws will lose their privileges.
8. The rules must be taken home and signed by the parents or guardians before open campus will be allowed for the student.
9. Open campus will begin on (date set by Administration).
10. Application forms are due on (date set by Administration). No exceptions will be allowed.
11. Students must have passed or met the state required standards on the MCA Math, Reading, and Writing exams.
12. Open Campus will also be based on the successful completion of the Class Trip.
13. Open Campus may include other expectations or conditions put in place by the Principal.
