STUDENT COUNCIL

I. PURPOSE

- A. The student council is organized to allow student participation in student affairs. Specifically, the purpose is to:
1. Allow students to participate in or manage various projects or programs involving the entire student body;
 2. Develop student responsibility, initiative, leadership, and school pride;
 3. Promote the welfare of the school through proper student-faculty relationships;
 4. Promote citizenship training;
 5. Promote general welfare;
 6. Aid in the internal organization of the school;
 7. Provide for pupil expression; and
 8. Furnish a working model government.

II. POWERS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The purpose of the Student Council is advisory and not policy making.

III. ORGANIZATION

The organization and supervision is the responsibility of the administration.
