### SENIOR CLASS TRIP

#### I. PURPOSE

- A. The senior class trip is a School Board sanctioned activity. It is supported by the Board to encourage a culminating class activity that is both educational and enjoyable for students. This trip is supported in lieu of other unsupervised activities that are not approved or supervised by the Board and staff. Students choosing not to participate are required to attend school as regularly scheduled.

#### II. PLANNING

- A. The senior class trip is planned by the senior class representatives under the guidance of the class advisors and principal. The trip will be approved by the School Board annually according to the following schedule:

Prior to February of Senior Year – Board reviews agenda, activities, motel/hotel arrangements, chaperones, and cost.

February of Senior Year – Final Board approval.

#### III. SUPERVISION

- A. The principal and/or senior class advisor will provide for adequate supervision depending on the size of the class and type of trip. At a minimum the trip will be supervised by two staff members (certified or classified) and two parents.

#### IV. FUNDING

- A. Each class is responsible for funding the senior trip with board promulgated rules and regulations. Any contribution (if any) by the board to the cost of the senior class trip will be determined regularly.
