TOURNAMENT ATTENDANCE

I. MSHSL TOURNAMENTS – MCW NOT PARTICIPATING

- A. The Martin County West does not pay for tickets, provide transportation, nor supervise students attending district, regional, or state tournaments in which MCW is not a participant.
- B. Students who meet these criteria may attend MSHSL Tournaments:
 - 1. The principal must receive a note from the parents or guardian one (1) week prior to the absence.
 - 2. Missed work must be made up and verified by the principal prior to the absence.
 - 3. Students not completing items one and two will be considered truant and will be handled according to the Disciplinary Policy - #502.
 - 4. Students must meet the minimum attendance standards outlined in the Disciplinary Policy, Attendance Section - #502.
- C. When school is in session, classes will be held as usual with students' and teachers' time being productively used.

II. MSHSL TOURNAMENTS – MCW PARTICIPATING

- A. School (K-12) may be cancelled or shortened on a school day in which a Martin County West High School team participates in a MSHSL tournament with the approval of the School Board. (See Policy #407)
- B. The school district will provide supervision, transportation, lodging, and other reasonable expenses for team participants, band members and cheerleaders if applicable. Other arrangements for transportation or lodging for these students must be approved by the high school principal.
- C. Distribution of student tickets will be coordinated by the school.
- D. Students attending who are not participating on the team or band will be the responsibility of the parent or guardian. This includes supervision, transportation, and lodging.

III. MSHSL TOURNAMENTS – MCW INDIVIDUAL QUALIFIERS

- A. School will not be cancelled or shortened on a school day in which an individual(s) participate in a MSHSL tournament.
- B. The school district will provide one room per 3 coaches, one room per 4 participants, supervision, transportation and meals applicable.

Any and all other arrangements will be coordinated through the high school principal.
