## VISITORS

### I. GENERAL

- A. All visitors must report to the building's main office.

### II. SPECIFIC

- A. No person, other than a student of this school building, teacher, administrator, or employee in this school district, shall be permitted to enter any classroom or circulate in a school building without first receiving permission from the office of the administration in charge of that school building or the office of the Superintendent of Schools.
- B. Such permission as described above shall be required only during the period when the school is in session and shall be for the purpose of preventing interruption of normal education functions. Permission shall not be required for anyone who is present in the building for the following purposes:
1. Attending any meeting on the premises of an organization which has been authorized by the school administration.
  2. Voting or aiding in the conduct of any legally called election.
  3. Attending any duly authorized athletic, recreational, cultural, or classroom event.
- C. Permission granted hereunder may be limited as to time or purpose and may be revoked by the administrator granting the same or the Superintendent of Schools at any time if in his/her opinion such visit is no longer in harmony with the proper conduct of the schools.

### III. VIOLATION OF THESE REGULATIONS IS PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN ONE YEAR OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000 OR BOTH. PURSUANT TO LAWS OF MINNESOTA, 1969, CHAPTER 767.
