



## **Sophomore Forecasting**

- All sophomores take Chemistry or Honors Chemistry to fulfill a science credit. Students must have departmental approval to enroll in Honors Chemistry. Please consult the course catalog or your current teacher for more details about enrollment requirements.
- All sophomores take World History A+B or Honors Human Geography to fulfill a social science credit. Students must complete an application and have departmental approval to enroll in Honors Human Geography. Please consult the course catalog for more details about enrollment requirements.
- It is recommended that you take Speech in sophomore year, but it is not required in sophomore year. It is a graduation requirement though, so if you do not take it as a sophomore, you will need to take it as a junior or senior.
- Have you taken any PE or Health credits yet? It is strongly recommended that you complete at least one course in each by the end of your sophomore year since you need two courses in each to graduate. All students must complete Health 1 by the end of sophomore year, so if you have not taken it yet, you need to forecast for it. Think about the Health 2 summer course as an option as well.
- For most of you, this is your first chance to take an Honors course. If you qualify for Honors courses, choose carefully which one(s) you forecast for and think about your workload balance.
- Remember, the more required courses you take now, the less you have to take as a junior or senior, which frees up more time for electives later.
