WHAT IS EARLY COLLEGE?

Early College High Schools (ECHS) are open-enrollment high schools that allow students least likely to attend college an opportunity to receive both a high school diploma and either an associate degree with 60 credit hours or some credit hours toward a baccalaureate degree.



GRADES

Students earn bonus points on High School GPA

Students can qualify for Dean's list

Low GPA can result in

disqualification of Financial Aid,
Scholarships, denial of entry to
University or denial of college credit
