UNSOLVED MYSTERIES: MARY CELESTE

The Mary Celeste was an amazing ship that was built in Canada but registered in America. This ship was honestly a pretty big mystery. On December 4, 1872, it was found in great condition at sea but under partial sail ... and the lifeboat and crew were missing! It also was filled with stuff and had all the captain's belongings. But none of the crew was ever heard from again. So why would they leave this ship? Well here's the facts.

Route and time stamp.

First let's recount what we know. The ship's lifeboat was gone, but the belongings were untouched. Well, we need to see what boats were passing the same place near the same time, but before that, we need to analyze the route and how much time it would take to cross the Atlantic Ocean. Let's see. The northern route usually took between 15 to 30 days. So it would have to be aborted at the earliest by December 29. Now let's calculate the proximity. The ship was found in the Azores. That means the ship drifted off in a north direction. So what does that mean? Well going north on the drift, it would move less than one mile an hour. Line a baking dish with graham crackers.


Whisk the milk and pudding mix together, then fold in the Cool Whip. Layer the pudding mixture and graham crackers according to the recipe.
