BRIER TERRACE MIDDLE SCHOOL 7TH GRADE ELECTIVES COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Welcome to Brier Terrace Middle School! Here is a list of our electives for incoming 7th graders. Please review them with your parent/guardian as you select your course requests and alternate requests.

Concert Band

(Pre-req 6th-grade Band) Concert Band is a year-long class made up of 7th graders who were in elementary band. This class is fun because we play our instruments every day, we play exciting music, and we get good quickly. Throughout the year we perform in large groups and small ensembles. Plus you get to know new people who quickly become a “band family.” We have several evening performances and go on field trips. It’s worth it to join Team Awesome!
(Year-Long)

Concert Orchestra

(Pre-req 6th-grade Orchestra) This course is for 7th graders who have played an orchestra instrument in 6th grade. Students will have the opportunity to perform exciting music, get better at playing their instruments and at reading music. This class will include field trips to festivals, performances for our school community and evening performances throughout the year. **(Year-Long)**

Art

Experience new ways to express yourself in art. Open to 7th & 8th graders who are interested in hands-on learning and would like to create high quality, exhibition-worthy projects in drawing, painting, and 3-D art. Whatever your skill level, you will enjoy how your talent develops.
(Semester-Long)

Foods

The Foods class promotes practical learning and life-long skills in areas of nutrition, basic cooking skills, meal planning and preparation. Students will prepare a meal for their families as their final project. Working in teams, students prepare a variety of foods. This class will bring out the chef in anyone. **(Semester-Long)**

Coding

Our Coding class is designed to introduce middle school students to the exciting world of coding and computer programming. Through a hands-on approach, students will learn fundamental concepts of coding, develop problem-solving skills, and gain confidence in their ability to create technology. Students will learn the basics of writing code, understanding algorithms, and debugging errors. No prior coding experience is required. **(Semester-Long)**

Sci-Ma-Tech

This semester-long Sci-Ma-Tech class is designed for both 7th and 8th grade students. In this class you will become certified to use the lab tooling, measure and create 3 view drawings as a resource while you build a solid fuel rocket and a tower that will hold over 100 pounds, weigh less than 25 grams and eject “bubba” the ping pong ball as it crashes to the ground. You will work with computer controlled lasers and 3D printers to create 5 projects including the popular LED sign project. Finally use your skills to design and build an Egg Crash Car that will provide safety for an egg as it experiences the three crashes of a head on collision. If you enjoy learning through hands-on projects, you are going to love Sci-Ma-Tech! **(Semester-Long)**
