#### A Note From the Nurse

As we turn the calendar to February, the number of respiratory illnesses will start to diminish. But it is not unusual for influenza illness cases to persist even into February and March. Whether its influenza, Strep throat, COVID or RSV (Respiratory Syncytial Virus) or gastrointestinal illnesses causing nausea, vomiting and diarrhea, two powerful tools for preventing or limiting spread of these hardy germs remain HANDWASHING and COVER YOUR COUGH.

Frequent handwashing during cold and flu and gastrointestinal virus illness season is an important tool in the prevention tool box. PARENTS are always teachers, by what we do and say. Perform handwashing with soap and water AFTER using the toilet or changing a diaper, BEFORE AND AFTER food preparation or eating, and anytime you cough into your hands or use a kleenex. Hand sanitizer is a good tool but it's hard to beat soap and water. Use a squirt of soap and work the soap into a lather with some water. Scrub the back of the hands, the palms, between the fingers and the finger tips for twenty seconds. Sing the ABC's song. Rinse your hands then dry them with a towel.

Encourage your children to cover their coughs and sneezes. An uncovered sneeze can shower viruses and bacteria on work surfaces, where others may pick them up on their hands. All it takes is putting a finger in a mouth or rubbing an eye and the virus or bacteria can be introduced into the body, setting an individual up for infection. So have Kleenex available for coughs or sneezes AND when a Kleenex isn't readily available, cough or sneeze into your upper sleeve or elbow.

Being sick is no fun and while illness happens, handwashing and covering your cough are two powerful but simple tools to reduce illness in the community.


## Valentines' Grush Cans




