Invites Sealed bid proposals for the following item:
Cured in Place Pipe (CIPP) Lining Service

Specifications may be picked up in the East Greenwich School Department Facilities Office located in the basement of East Greenwich Town Hall, 125 Main Street, East Greenwich, RI 02818 between the hours of **9:00am and 2:00pm on or after Monday, March 10th, 2025.**

Each bidder is requested to deliver their bid **no later than 2:00pm on Thursday, March 20th, 2025,** to the EG School Department Facilities Office, located in the basement of East Greenwich Town Hall, 125 Main Street, East Greenwich, RI. Submissions via electronic transmittal will be accepted 10 minutes before the bid closing time and should include a read receipt. Bids are to be emailed to Rwilmarth@egsd.net with the subject "CIPP Repair". All bids will be publicly opened and read.

Each bid submitted must contain the name of the bidder and the bid amount, which will be recorded. For each bid submitted, the envelope must **be sealed and clearly marked "CIPP Repair"**.

The School Committee reserves the right to waive certain formalities or to reject any and all bids.

An award is given in writing to the lowest responsive bid. A bid is deemed responsive when it.

1. Complies with the specifications.
2. Promises performance by time and date.
3. Project costs within budget.

Any bids which do not conform to the aforementioned provisions are deemed not responsive to the bid invitation. The School Committee reserves the right not to consider those bids.

After the bid is awarded, all documents pertaining to the winning bid will be available for public inspection.

Corrections or withdrawals may be allowed only with respect to regulations issued by the School Committee or their agent.

If all of the bids exceed the available funds, the School Committee may:

1. Re-solicit bids under revised specifications,

or;
2. Enter into competitive negotiations with the three (3) lowest and responsible and responsive bidders.

A reasonable inquiry to determine the responsibility of a bidder or offer may be conducted. Failure to promptly supply information related to such an inquiry may be grounds for a finding of non-responsibility. Any such information supplied is confidential. REQUEST FOR BID:
Cured in Place Pipe (CIPP) Lining Service

The East Greenwich School Department seeks a vendor to install approx. 150 linear feet of CIPP lining for a 6” under slab sanitary line.

Vendor should have Certificate of Insurance Umbrella up to \$5,000,000.

Epoxy liner Specs: Maxliner 4D felt liner (see data page attached)

Resin specs: Maxliner UV resin (see data page attached)

Sewertronics Speedylight UltraViolet Curing machine (See specs attached)

Procedure and process

- A. Video inspect pipe using CCTV camera
- B. Descale pipe to loosen scale and debris from cast iron pipe via Picote milling machine, ensure pipe is milled smooth
- C. Hydro jet line to remove debris loosened during the descaling process
- D. Wet out/ impregnate 4D maxliner liner, on mechanical rolling bench, at a rate of 11lbs of resin per foot resulting in a 3mm-4mm thickness liner
- E. Shoot/ invert liner from drum into pipe
- F. Insert UV light (Large light head) curing the newly installed liner at .75 to 1 ft per minute
- G. Reinstate/ cut out lateral connections/ branch lines with Dancuttter robotic cutting machine, ensuring all connections are open and free of obstruction.

PLEASE NOTE:

Bid is for the period of **March 2025 through May 2025** as determined by the East Greenwich School Department. Depending on product availability date will vary based on school Schedule to coincide with a vacation period.

Bid proposals will be received in the Facilities office in an envelope clearly marked “CIPP Lining Service” until 2:00 p.m. on Thursday March 20th, 2025. Each bidder is requested to deliver their bid no later than 2:00pm on March 20th, 2025. Submissions via electronic transmittal will be accepted 10 minutes prior to the bid opening time and should include a read receipt. bids are to be emailed to Rwilmarth@egsd.net with the subject “Cipp Lining Service”. All bids will then be publicly opened and read.

Bids will be opened and read out loud at **2:00 p.m. on Thursday March 20th, 2025.**

All bids will be evaluated and will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder.

The East Greenwich School Department reserves the right to waive all formalities and reject any and all bids not deemed in the best interest of the Town of East Greenwich.
