



In accordance with Texas Education Code 28.004 and Senate Bill 9, a film on human growth and development, “Always Changing and Growing Up,” will be shown to fifth grade students during the spring semester. All lessons meet the requirements that are mandated by the state and are aligned with the Texas Essentials Knowledge and Skills (TEKS).

This information is being presented to bring an understanding of the developmental changes your student can expect as a normal part of growing up. This content is intended to initiate conversations between you and your student about the physical, emotional, and social changes that occur during adolescence. If you have already spoken with your student about this topic, the program will refresh the facts you have offered and reaffirm the healthy behaviors they have learned from you.

Parents/caregivers are welcome to preview the film, “Always Changing and Growing Up,” for boys and girls, as well as more information to support you in these conversations with your student.
