Counselor Referral System

Course Registration for 2025-2026 School Year

Please see the information below regarding the 2025-2026 $10^{\mbox{th}}$ Grade Course Selection process.

If you have questions regarding course registration, please email the designated counselor based on students' last name. Mrs. Isaac is facilitating course registration for all students with the last names "A-K". Ms. Sumlar is facilitating course registration for all students with the last names "L-Z".

All course registration choices must be entered in PowerSchool to insure your child has a schedule for the 2025-2026 school year.

Honors Courses

All honors, PRE-AP and AP courses require a contract. Students who do not turn in an honors contract will be removed from the requested honors, Pre-AP, and/or AP course.

PowerSchool Lock Date: Students will have until March 23, 2025, to make changes to their course registration choices in PowerSchool. PowerSchool will be locked on March 24th, 2025, and students will no longer be able to make changes in PowerSchool. Students will have to email their designated counselor to make changes after March 23rd.

Verification Sheets: In April, students will receive a verification sheet to bring home. You and your child will review their course registration selections and decide if there are any errors or classes that need to be changed. Please request all changes on the verification sheet and return it to their assigned counselor. The counselor will update the course selections in PowerSchool. If there is an issue with the requested changes, the assigned counselor will meet with the student and contact the parent by email if necessary.

Final Date for Course selection changes in PowerSchool: Students' last day of school will be Thursday, May 22, 2025 (this is a half-day of school). This will also be the last and final day that students, or parents may request a change to course selections for the 2025-2026 school year. No changes will be made after Thursday, May 22, 2025!
