New York State Assessments

Beginning in April students in grades 7 and 8 will take the New York State English Language Arts and Mathematic Exams. Grade 8 will also take the New York State Science Exam in May. These test will be computer based and completed on students' assigned Chromebooks. Teachers have been practicing using the online platform with students successfully. We encourage students to complete these exams carefully as they are helpful to our school district in the following ways:

- These tests provide teachers and schools with information that can be used to guide their instruction and class planning and help them to understand how well students are progressing in the skills and concepts being taught in the classroom.
- Results from the tests help us identify achievement gaps among individual students, and grade levels.

Without participation, we lack that information making it more difficult for us to recognize gaps and provide support and resources to the students who need them.
