

Instructions to Qualify for ACC/Dual Credit Courses - TSI STEPS		DUE: June 4, 2025
1	<p>Sign-up for a TSI Testing Date -> current options - Feb. 26, Mar. 26, Apr. 30, June 4. (or you can always go to an ACC campus if that works better for you)</p> <p>The TSI Test will be given at the Scudder campus and will be able to accommodate up to 25 students at each testing session. The cost of the test this year is; Full TSI Test (reading, writing, math) - \$20 and each individual part - \$7.</p> <p>Sign-up by doing 2 things: 1 - Pay through the webstore at this https://tinyurl.com/tsipay25. 2 - Fill out this https://tinyurl.com/signuptsi25.</p> <p>NOTE: The TSI Test in WISD is offered during the school day - so YOU need to think through what classes you have and make arrangements with your teachers</p> <p><i>On TSI Test Day - Bring your PAA Completion Certificate (see next step) and Photo ID (Driver's License or School ID).</i></p>	
2	<p>Complete the Pre-Assessment Activity (PAA) www.austincc.edu/tsiprep and forward or print the certificate to give to Mrs.Vannoy.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● This MUST be done BEFORE TSI test date ● You will have to show proof - the certificate before testing

3	<p>Complete the ACC Application for enrollment. Pages 3 - 6 give you detailed instructions, created by an ACC Coordinator, just follow along step-by-step.</p> <p>*Through the application process you will receive an email telling you what your <u>ACCeID</u> is. <u>You must have your ACCEID to continue the process.</u></p>	
4	<p>Complete the required new student HS Programs online Orientation and Assessment. https://hsorientation.austincc.edu/</p> <p>*Failure to complete the orientation and its assessment quiz will result in a registration hold!</p>	
5	<p>EMAIL Mrs.Vannoy your ACCEID. This confirms you have done the previous 4 steps and are ready to take ACC classes.</p>

NEW STEP - ONLINE CONTRACT
