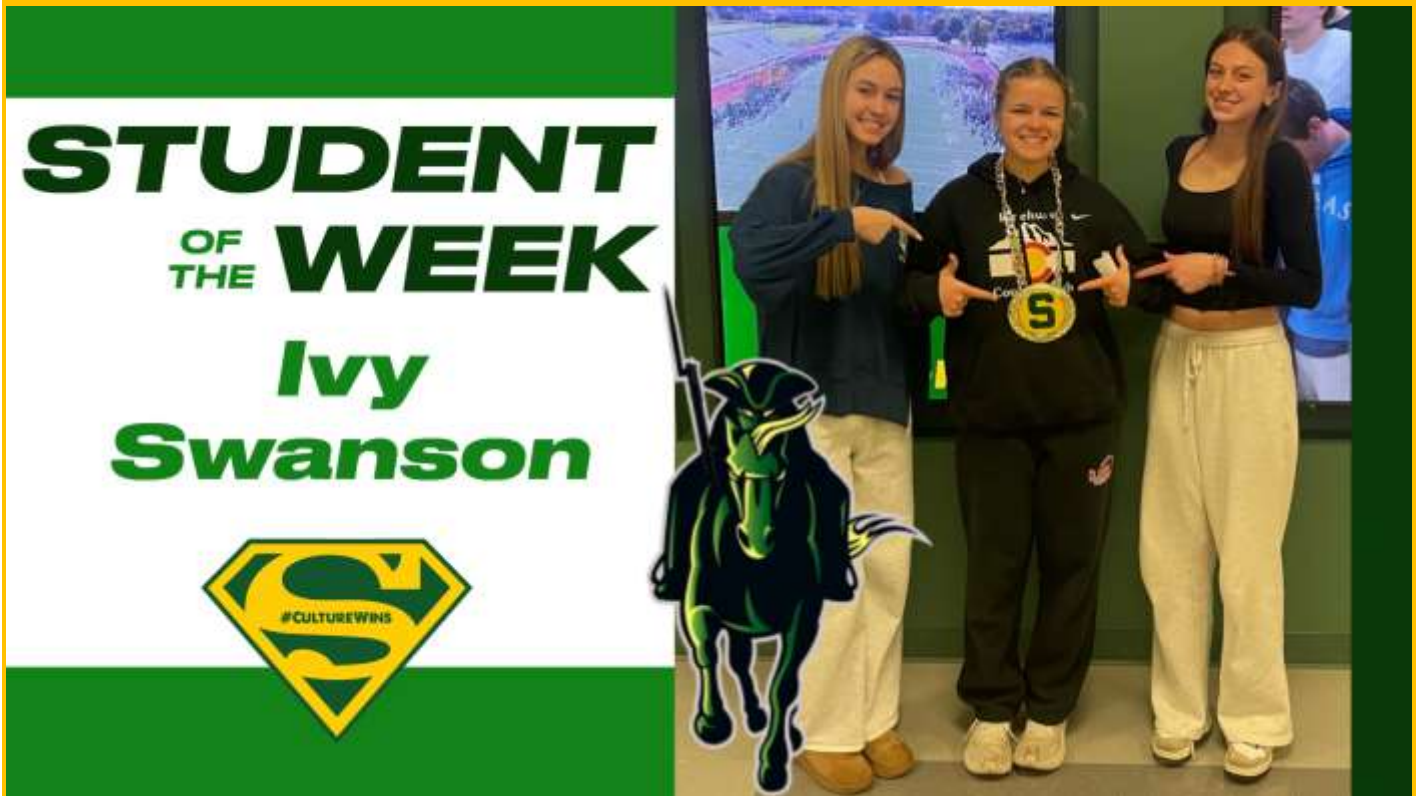

Hello! My name is Memo Rodriguez and I am the Shawnee Mission School District Attendance Specialist for the South high school feeder area. I am here mainly to provide follow-up monitoring of students identified as needing support for chronic absenteeism, but other functions I perform are:

- I serve as a liaison between students, families, and school teams to facilitate positive student attendance.
- I cooperate with representatives from social services and law enforcement agencies in cases of mutual interests.
- I manage all associated paperwork, arrange for educational facilitators, connect families with needed community resources.
- I communicate and work effectively and cooperatively with members of the school district and community to promote student attendance.
- I work effectively with chronically absent as well as truant students and their families.
- I connect families struggling with attendance with appropriate school and community resources.

My hours at South high school are Monday through Friday 7 A.M. to 12 P.M.

Indian Woods middle school hours are Monday through Friday 12:30 P.M. to 3:30 P.M.

## Personal Technology Procedures

At the January 13, 2025, Board of Education meeting, the Board approved policy JCDC: Restrictions on Possession and Use of Personal Electronic Devices. [Click here to read the SMSD policy.](#) Full implementation of this policy will begin on February 3, 2025.

This policy was developed in response to feedback and concerns raised by students, parents, and staff about how these devices can disrupt learning and negatively impact the mental and emotional health of students. Our mission, as defined in our [SMSD Strategic Plan](#), continues to be that we help each student achieve their full potential.

This fall, a Strategic Plan Action Team worked to create a policy recommendation on age-appropriate use of personal electronic devices in our schools. Their thoughtful recommendations included input from 25 Action Team members representing teachers, administrators, students, parents, and community members. Their work also included feedback gathered through a district-wide Thought Exchange, ensuring many voices and opinions were included. This process has also been informed with the advice of SMSD principals, educators of all age levels, and students and staff in the Superintendent's advisory committees. The Shawnee Mission School District is committed to providing highly effective and consistent learning spaces across the district.

### Personal Electronic Device Policy

- Personal electronic devices to include the use of cell phones and headphones (other than smartwatches) should be silenced and stored during class. Teachers may provide a secure storage option in the classroom.
- Devices can be used between classes and at lunch but must remain silenced and put away during class time unless used for learning with teacher approval.

*Note: In rare cases, administration may approve exceptions.*

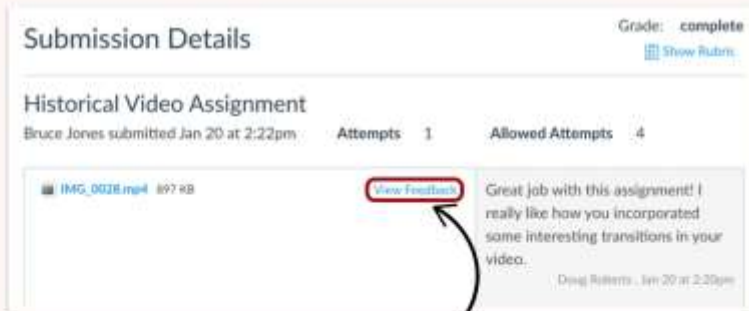

# Canvas Feedback

## Tech Tips for Students & Families

Through Canvas, teachers can provide feedback on a student's progress in a course in a few ways including the grade, comment(s) on an assignment, and rubric. This can give students important information to use to be successful on future assignments.

### Both students & observers can see feedback on Canvas



When you click on an assignment, some comments can be found on the right hand side. These are usually general feedback for the entire assignment.

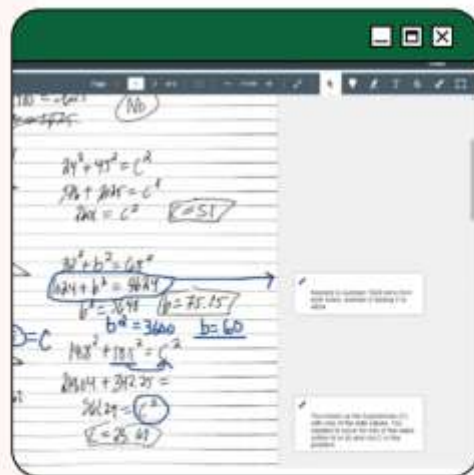
If you see the blue "View Feedback" link after clicking on an assignment, click on it to see more specific comments or annotations on the document submitted. Some teachers will add several comments on specific parts of the assignment itself. The math image below is an example of what it looks like.

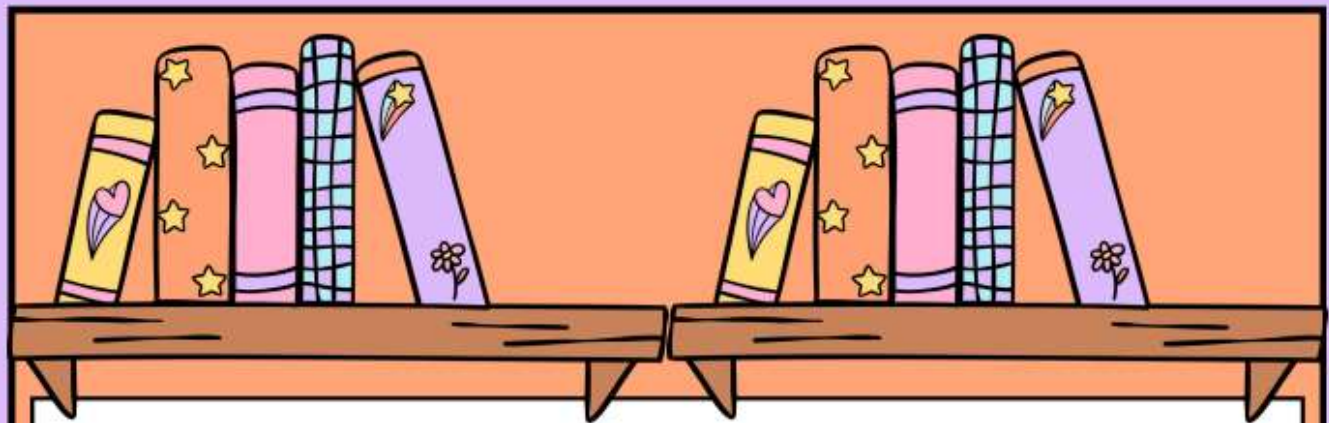
### So I got a grade or a comment on an assignment...now what?

Focus on the positive: What did you do well?

Look to the future: How can the feedback help you improve on a future assignment, test, or project?

Families, you can help your student by talking through comments left by teachers on assignments. You can also use suggestions for improvement to help your student on future assignments.

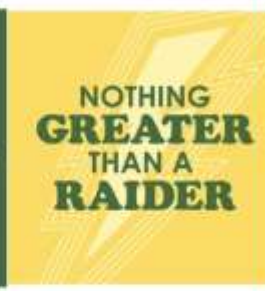
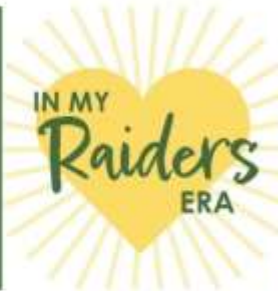
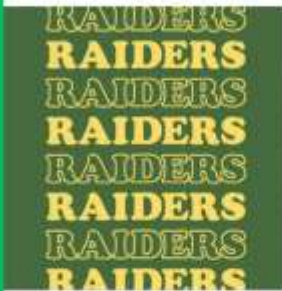
