Rationale

The Kindergarten student needs opportunities to develop awareness and skills that will positively benefit them in school and the community.

Course Description

Mehlville School District Guidance and Counseling activities for the Kindergarten student will consist of experiences in the areas of learning skills, making decisions, understanding and getting along with others, accepting self, learning about personal safety and career awareness.

Course Objectives

1. The student will demonstrate appropriate listening behaviors with 75% competency as assessed by teacher observation of classroom activities. (CA6; 4.6)
2. The student will demonstrate knowledge of how to make good decisions with 75% competency as assessed by performance on classroom activities and teacher observation. (CA6; 3.4)
3. The student will demonstrate knowledge of how to get along with others with 75% competency as assessed by teacher observation and anecdotal records. (CA6; 4.6)
4. The student will demonstrate the ability to identify feelings with 75% frequency as assessed by counselor-made quizzes. (H/PE2; 4.7)
5. The student will demonstrate how to make safe choices within his/her environment with 90% competency as assessed by teacher-made quizzes. (H/PE5; 4.7)
6. The student will demonstrate knowledge of community helpers with 90% competency as assessed by classroom activities. (CA6; 4.3)

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
