Butterfly Effect Projects in Full Swing: The Butterfly Effect Club at Churchill is a group of students who engage in random acts of kindness and larger organized projects that benefit both the school and community at large. We are very proud of our students for their kindness, generosity, self-directed leadership, and commitment to help others. Student projects are in full swing and two projects that I would like to highlight this week include:
 - A 7th grade student is collecting gently used children's books such as board books or simple chapter books for children up to age 8. The books will be donated to the NJ Department of Children and Families foster program. If you have any books that you would like to donate, please have your student drop off the books at our collection bins located either outside the main office in the south building or outside the cafeteria.
 - Two 9th grade students are organizing a 5K Walk on Sunday, March 16 at the EBHS Track. Proceeds from the walk will benefit the K. Hovnanian Children's Hospital. Please open the flyer that is attached to this message for more details.
- 5. Student Council/PBSIS Food Drive: The Churchill Student Council and our Positive Behavior Supports in Schools initiative have teamed up to organize a food drive that



will support the Middlesex County Emergency Food Distribution Network. This network supplies food to over 120 local food pantries, soup kitchens, and social services agencies. The drive runs through Friday, March 14th. We are collecting food and supply donations in A-Day homerooms. Students in the top three homerooms that donate the most food will earn vouchers for free cookies from our cafeteria. We are collecting the following items: canned food, granola bars, pasta, paper products, soap, toothpaste, and shampoo, diapers, wipes, dry beans, and canned soups and canned stews. This drive is a great way for our students to help members of our local community who need support.

- 6. 9th Grade Career Fair: Students who are in 9th grade will have the opportunity to meet with a variety of professionals from many career fields and trades on Tuesday, March 18th at our 9th Grade Career Fair. This fair is organized by our school counseling department and the goal is to help 9th grade students learn about different career options as they prepare to transition to EBHS next year. Students are called down to the fair We appreciate the professionals who are taking time out of their day to meet with our 9th graders and provide them with helpful career information and experience.
