It was a pleasure seeing our families participate in our spring parent/teacher conferences yesterday. These are great opportunities for us to partner together to ensure success at school.

Earlier this week, 93 of our students competed at the CT’s DECA Conference in Southington. 1,500 high schoolers across the state presented prepared presentations, or participated in “on the spot” role play events. They covered a variety of business topics from accounting to finance to marketing, and everything in between. Amazingly, 37 THS students placed in the top three of their competitive events and are now eligible to attend the International Career Development Conference (ICDC) in Orlando, FL! We are incredibly proud of them and their Advisor, Ms. Rusate.
