A. Call to Order

camp, and other classroom materials needed like headphones. In addition, we will be continuing to spend our parent engagement money on parent nights. We are currently looking into a science night for our families. Prop 28 funds were asked about and it was shared that we have a teacher who is working with 4th and 5th graders in the area of Reader's Theater. These students are learning reading skills and applying them the arts through dramatic script reading and writing.
