The **VISION** of Dual Language Two-Way Immersion is to develop children into **bilingual**, **biliterate**, and **bicultural** students who **love learning** and are able to think critically.





Dual Language Two-Way Immersion Program Overview

Dual Language education is an effective approach to developing language proficiency and literacy in English and Spanish.

Two-way immersion, is one model of Bilingual education. It integrates native English speakers (English Proficient Learners) and native Spanish Speakers (Identified EB-Emergent Bilingual Learners) for **academic content attainment** through English and Spanish beginning in Kinder.

The Dual Language program at Boerne ISD promotes bilingualism and biliteracy, grade level academic achievement and cross-cultural competence in all students.

Students maintain their native language while adding another language, and they develop pride in their own culture while developing an understanding of others.



Dual Language Two-Way Immersion Program Overview

As mandated by the Texas Commissioner's rules classes must be composed of 60% native Spanish Speakers (EB) students and 40% native English Speakers (EP) students.

The building of classes is dependent on the number of Spanish dominant (EB-Emergent Bilingual) students enrolled in that grade level.

Emergent Bilingual students are identified by mandated state assessments.



Dual Language Two-Way Immersion Program Overview


The Two-Way Immersion Dual Language Program in Boerne ISD is an educational program that provides instructional practices unique to dual language for native Spanish speakers and native English speakers in both languages.

Program follows the 90/10 framework.

Students in the early grades will receive most of their academic instruction in Spanish.



Participation in Dual Language Two-Way Immersion / Spanish Immersion Program

Students **participating** in the Boerne ISD Dual Language Bilingual Two-Way Immersion Program in their Kindergarten year, will not be eligible to initiate the enrollment process and/or participate in the Spanish Immersion Program in their 1st grade year. Participation commitment in the Dual Language Bilingual Two-Way Immersion Program adheres to class composition standards provided by 19 TAC Chapter 89, Texas Education Agency.

Students on the Boerne ISD Dual Language Bilingual Two-Way Immersion Program **WAITLIST** will be eligible to initiate the enrollment process in the Spanish Immersion Program of their 1st Grade school year, if the student meets the Boerne ISD eligibility requirements of the SIP.



Parental Support

Things to consider....

- Foundational Literacy- Early literacy skills lay the groundwork for academic achievement, language immersion and lifelong learning.
- **Student Behavior** Parents are encouraged to carefully consider behavior concerns. It's important to recognize that students facing language impairments or processing difficulties <u>may</u> encounter challenges.
- Parental Commitment -Regular attendance is essential for student success. Those who frequently miss classes or arrive late will struggle to keep pace with the demands of learning a new language and new academic content.
