Mehlville School District Guidance and Counseling Grade 3, Duration 1 Year

Rationale

The student in grade 3 needs opportunities to develop awareness and skills that will positively benefit them in school and the community.

Course Description

Mehlville School District Guidance and Counseling activities for the student in grade 3 will consist of experiences in the areas of learning skills, making decisions, understanding and getting along with others, understanding and accepting self, personal responsibilities and career awareness.

Course Objectives

- 1. The student will demonstrate knowledge of how learning skills relate to school success with 80% competency as assessed by verbal/written quizzes. (CA6; 1.10)
- 2. The student will demonstrate understanding of consequences as they relate to a decision-making process with 75% competency as assessed by classroom activities. (CA6; 3.3)
- 3. The student will demonstrate knowledge of how to resolve conflicts and get along with others with 80% frequency as assessed by teacher observation and anecdotal records. (CA6; 3.2)
- 4. The student will demonstrate the ability to identify and build on personal strengths with 80% frequency as assessed by counselormade quizzes. (H/PE2; 4.7)
- 5. The student will demonstrate knowledge of personal responsibilities with 80% competency as assessed by written performance tasks. (CA6; 4.3)
- 6. The student will demonstrate knowledge of the career pathways with 80% competency as assessed by written performance tasks. (CA6; 4.8)
