Guidance and Counseling - 4th Grade

Rationale

The student in grade 4 needs opportunities to develop awareness and skills that will positively benefit them in school and the community.

Course Description

Mehlville School District Guidance and Counseling activities for the student in grade 4 will consist of experiences in the areas of learning skills, making decisions, understanding and getting along with others, understanding and accepting self, personal responsibilities and career awareness.

Course Objectives

1. The student will demonstrate knowledge of how learning skills relate to school success with 90% competency as assessed by verbal/written quizzes. (CA6; 1.10)

2. The student will demonstrate the ability to evaluate consequences as they relate to a decision making process with 80% competency as assessed by classroom activities related to decision-making. (CA6; 3.3)

3. The student will demonstrate the ability to understand empathy and to recognize the uniqueness of self and others with 80% competency as assessed by performance on classroom activities and teacher made activity sheets. (CA6; 2.3)

4. The student will demonstrate the ability to recognize and communicate how to manage personal feelings with 80% competency as assessed by verbal/written quizzes and teacher input. (H/PE2; 4.7)

5. The student will demonstrate knowledge of personal responsibilities with 90% competency as assessed by written performance tasks. (CA6; 4.3)

6. The student will demonstrate knowledge of career pathways with 90% competency as assessed by written performance tasks. (CA6; 4.8)
