Guidance and Counseling - 5th Grade

Rationale

The student in grade 5 needs opportunities to develop awareness and skills that will positively benefit them in school and the community.

Course Description

Mehlville School District Guidance and Counseling activities for the student in grade 5 will consist of experiences in the areas of learning skills, making decisions, understanding self and getting along with others, knowledge of the harmful effects of drugs and alcohol, middle school expectations and career exploration.

Course Objectives

1. The student will demonstrate knowledge of how learning skills relate to success in school and work with 80% competency as assessed by counselor-made written quiz. (CA6; 1.10)

2. The student will demonstrate the ability to use a decision-making process with 80% competency as assessed by verbal presentation of group project. (CA6; 4.1)

3. The student will demonstrate knowledge of strategies for dealing with peer pressure with 80% competency as assessed by counselor-made activity sheet. (H/PE2; 3.2)

4. The student will demonstrate knowledge of the harmful effects of drugs and alcohol with 80% competency as assessed by performance on pre-test and post-test. (H/PE5; 3.2)

5. The student will demonstrate awareness of middle school expectations with 80% competency as assessed by counselor-made quiz over stated criteria. (SS6; 4.8)

6. The student will demonstrate awareness of personal strengths and interests as related to career choices with 80% competency as assessed by counselor given interest inventory. (SS6; 4.8)
