Mehlville School District Special Education Grades 9 - 12, Duration 1 Year, 1 Credit

Rationale

Everyday Social Skills is designed to meet the individual needs of the student who has difficulties in academic areas and is not able to gain information and knowledge at the level within the general education class.

Course Description

This course covers selected topics in Social Skills. A primary focus is for the student to learn independent/daily living skills to become as independent as possible in skills that will continue beyond the school experience. Group interaction, discussion and cooperation during group role-playing and problem-solving sessions will be commonplace.
