Course Description:

The student will build on previous stagecraft experience to explore an understanding of, operation, and management of the scene shop, as well as studying different and advanced techniques of theatrical productions.

Course Rationale:

Theatre Stagecraft II is a course in which students demonstrate their experience, leadership, and skill development as a global citizen. This manifests in the form of, identifying and distributing tasks in set construction, and other aspects of technical theatre. Emphasis will be placed on teaching and cultivating the skills essential to the creation of a tactile presentation. The course culminates in a co-curricular presentation of a play. Students cooperatively solve artistic and intellectual problems in this instance arising in the creation of sets and other aspects of technical theatre.

Course Objectives:

- The student will define and use stagecraft terminology. (A+ Reading)
- The student will distinguish and explain the physical stage and its equipment. (A+ Writing)
- The student will understand and demonstrate the role and functions of the technical director in live theatre. (A+ Speaking and Listening)
- The student will be able to explain the different types of stagecraft techniques and materials. (A+ Research)
- The student will have hands-on experience in advanced stagecraft techniques for the theatre.
