Course Description:

This course provides a variety of hands-on design projects in relation to contemporary and historic culture. Students will have the opportunity to use the knowledge gained from their art foundation classes to create projects from a variety of materials. The student will be introduced to the areas of surface design, decorative arts, and fiber arts. Cultural research and global connections will be explored. This course has a \$10.00 lab fee. It is beneficial to have both 2-D and 3-D Art Foundations prior to taking this course.

Course Rationale:

Mixed Media provides a contemporary hands-on approach that integrates cultural, global, and historic appreciation of the arts. Mixed Media develops visual literacy, spatial intelligence, dexterous abilities, three-dimensional/two-dimensional problem-solvings skills, and media understanding. The incorporation of projects tied to culture leads to enhanced understanding of our global community.

Course Objectives

- The student will demonstrate the use of a variety of materials to support innovative and creative thought.
- The student will produce at least three bodies of work using a variety of media. The student will read about and discuss surface design, decorative arts, and fiber arts. (A+ Reading, A+ Speaking and Listening)
- The student will research and write about a variety of historical and cultural themes. (A+ Writing, A+Research)
