The students will have opportunities to develop more creative and imaginative drawings. Observation, perception, and problem solving skills will be used to develop representational drawings. Inspiration from past and contemporary artists will be used to examine the countless drawing possibilities.</p> <p>There is a \$10 lab fee for this course.</p>	
Course Rationale:	
<p>Drawing II will expand upon the fundamental drawing skills developed in Drawing I. Problem solving skills taught in drawing two will increase the compositional solutions, drawing techniques, and creative thinking processes to develop more challenging drawing compositions. Students will develop increased visual literacy, dexterous abilities, two-dimensional problem-solvings skills, and media understanding. Students will continue to take advantage of the countless benefits of drawing that guides the students' understanding of themselves, and their world through increased personal choice.</p>
