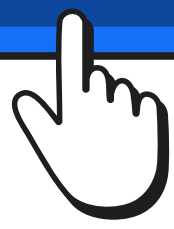

Session 2: August 11-14, 2025	8:00 AM - 3:00 PM

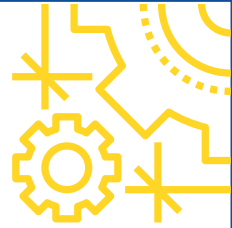
