As per NJAC 6A:23A-7.3, the proposed budget provides for a maximum expenditure amount that may be allotted for travel and expense reimbursement. The maximum amount of travel and expense reimbursement for the 2024-2025 budget was \$10,494. As of March 1, 2025 the amount spent to date is \$5,282.63. The 2025-2026 tentative budget includes a maximum travel appropriation of \$11,546. The School Business Administrator shall track and record these costs to insure that the maximum amount is not exceeded. Included in the 2025-2026 proposed budget is a maximum regular business travel amount of \$1,500 per employee.

Further be it resolved, the Stillwater Township Board of Education approves the use of \$132,354 in Enrollment Adjustment, which will support instructional costs in the 2025-2026 fiscal year budget.

Further be it resolved, the Stillwater Township Board of Education approves the use of \$119,736 in Healthcare Adjustment, which will support increased costs of healthcare in the 2025-2026 fiscal year budget.

Further be it resolved, that included in line 630, Budgeted Withdrawal from Maintenance Reserve is \$80,000 for parking lot repairs and general maintenance costs.

This proposed budget includes sufficient funds to provide curriculum and instruction which will enable all students to achieve the New Jersey Student Learning Standards, and is in compliance with N.J.S.A. 18A and N.J.A.C. Title 6 and 6A.

4. BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Stillwater Township Board of Education approves the submission of the 2025-2026 PEA (Preschool Education Aid) Grant Application to the NJ Department of Education, Division of Early Childhood Education (Grant application and execute a grant contract with the New Jersey Department of Education for four full-day Pre-K classrooms).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board formally approves the budget workbook and narrative submission for the grant listed above for a total award of \$908,922 of PEA aid based on per pupil costs, 25% Carryover deduction of \$-52,829, \$47,838 general fund contribution as required, and the use of \$111,327 in carry over funds. Grand total of the 2025-2026 anticipated budget of \$1,015,258.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the school administrators are hereby authorized to submit an electronic grant application to the New Jersey Department of Education on behalf of the Stillwater Township Board of Education.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Superintendent and Business Administrator are hereby authorized to sign the grant agreement on behalf of the Stillwater Township Board of Education and that their signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement and approves the execution of the grant agreement.
