NJGPA TESTING - 11th GRADE

The District will administer the NJ Graduation Proficiency Assessment (NJGPA) to all 11th grade students this week. Please read through this <u>linked document</u> for all details and information. All 11th grade students are expected to arrive at school at 7:35 to take their scheduled exam.

Bus Transportation for all 9th, 10th, and 12th Grade Non-testing Students:

Due to the testing schedule, there will be an additional bus run on March 11, 12, 13, and 14 for all non-testing students. If your child is a regular bus rider, he/she will need to be at their regular bus stop 2 hours and 45 minutes after the normal bus pick-up time. This will assure their arrival to school by 10:00 am. All Seniors who drive to school should also plan to arrive by 10:00 am.



BOYS STATE 2025 LEADERSHIP OPPORTUNITY FOR JUNIOR BOYS


