



Prom and Attendance & Discipline

Hey Terriers! With Prom approaching just a few reminders about the importance of class attendance and discipline. In order to enjoy fun activities like dances, you need to do your part in following rules, attending your classes, and being on time to class!

Make sure that you don't land on the No-Go list! You will not be able to purchase a ticket or attend the dance if you are placed on the No-Go list

ATTENDANCE: Attendance will be checked prior to students purchasing tickets. If a student is suspended, for whatever reason, within 45-school days (weekends and holidays are not counted as school days) of an RHS dance, they will be excluded from attending that dance. In addition, 45 period absences marked with attendance codes A, C or U from the start of the semester up until the date of the dance will lead a student to be excluded from attending any dance. This policy will remain in effect until the day of the dance. In this situation, the student will be excluded from the dance and they will receive a reimbursement for the cost of their ticket. RHS is not responsible for any costs incurred in preparation for the dance (dresses, tuxedos, limousines, etc.).

TARDY POLICY: Redlands High School believes that success in school is dependent upon punctual, regular attendance and quality instructional minutes. It is also our goal to instill skills necessary for college and career readiness, including but not limited to: responsibility, organization, punctuality, and respect. To this end, students must regularly attend class on time, ready to learn. Students will be **excluded from participating in extracurricular activities including dances** once they have accrued 15+ tardies from the start of the semester the dance is scheduled in. Students must be cleared from the No-Go list in order to purchase a dance ticket. If a student gets placed on the No-Go list after their ticket is purchased they will receive a reimbursement for the cost of their ticket. Students may serve campus detention to be removed from the No-Go list. The full [RHS Tardy Policy](#) can be found on the RHS Website.

After-school detentions are held on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. Students should report to Room 483 on North Campus at 3:30, and their detention will end at 4:30 pm. Failure to serve an after-school detention without a valid medical excuse from a parent/guardian will result in the student being required two after-school detentions. Excused after-school detentions must be served within one week. If a student continues to fail to serve their assigned after-school detention, further disciplinary consequences will be assigned by administration.

DISCIPLINE: Students who violate district or school rules and regulations may be subject to discipline including, but not limited to, suspension, expulsion or transfer to alternative programs, referral to a student success team or counseling services, **or denial of participation in extracurricular or co-curricular activities** or other privileges in accordance with Board policy and administrative regulation.

Any student who has been suspended within 45 school days of a dance, will be placed on the No-Go List. This includes serving an In House Suspension or Class Suspension.

DANCE CONTRACT: Students whose parents/guardians have not confirmed the Dance Contract through their Aeries Parent Portal, will not be allowed to attend any dances. Dance Contracts must be verified by Ms. Stanley or Ms. Kirk before a student will be removed from the No-Go List and allowed to purchase a dance ticket.
