THE MUSIC OF LENT

Winter Ordinary time is now behind us. This year, Lent begins three weeks later than last year, so we were lulled into the sounds and sights of Ordinary Time. But Triduum and Easter are the highest of our liturgical feasts, and as such, create the most distinctive of changes from Ordinary Time. We move from the Mass of Joy and Peace Eucharistic Acclamations (Gloria, Sanctus, Mystery of Faith, Amen, Lamb of God) to the chanted Belmont Mass. We sing this setting for our Lent and Advent seasons. The simple chant setting announces that something has changed, Jesus is journeying to the Cross and his Resurrection, and we are a part of that journey. Our gathering rite each week will accompany the procession, greeting, Penitential Rite and Collect as we sing “Hold us in your mercy...” We sing texts that are so primary to our observance of this season: “Lead us, Lord, into the desert, lead us through the wilderness. Through this journey we will follow....,” “In These Days of Lenten Journey,” “In the Cross of Christ,” and each week we are sent forth singing “Jesus, remember me, when you come into your kingdom.” Our songs are powerful prayers, and I hope you will sing the Lenten songs throughout this journey to the Triduum.


