#### Keystone Degrees



To earn a Keystone Degree, a member must first earn the Greenhand and Chapter Degrees, complete 25 hours of community service, participate in at least 15 FFA activities, demonstrate leadership skills, advocate for agriculture and the FFA, and have 300 hours outside of school and \$1,000 invested in a supervised agricultural experience (SAE).
