# WHO WE ARE

The Transition Academy provides instruction to students who have achieved all of their credits required for graduation but who have not achieved their secondary transition goals and objectives. Instruction is provided in employment, post-secondary education and training and independent living skills. Academic instruction is embedded in secondary transition activities such as budget development, menu planning, cooking, and arts and crafts. Students also learn employment skills while working as a small group at job sites in the community with supervision and coaching provided by the program staff. A focus on recreation and leisure activities is also embedded in the program with a focus on developing age-appropriate social skills and leisure activities.

Students are considered for eligibility into the program based on a referral from the case manager in grade 12, followed by a review of progress on the secondary transition goals and objectives and an inperson observation of the student by the Transition Academy teacher and program administrator.
