Dear Families,

As you receive this edition of the Challenger News, we are preparing for a well-deserved Spring Break beginning on March 10th through March 24th. As Monday, March 24th is a designated Teacher Workday we will look forward to having your children return on Tuesday, March 25th.

Thank you to the many families who attended the PTO's Annual Sweetheart/Family Dance. A special thank you to our PTO for organizing this special event. It was well attended and was a great success!

When we return from break, we will be gearing up to begin our AASA state assessments for grades 3 - 5. These assessments will occur between March 31st and April 18th. It is critical that your 3rd - 5th children take this assessment, first and foremost to measure their growth this year against the Arizona Standards of their respective grade level, and secondly because their attendance and participation during the test will reflect on whether we achieve AYP (Adequate Yearly Progress). Please ensure that your children are present and prepared on all testing days. Absenteeism during any portion of the test will require a makeup time to be scheduled. It is a much more positive experience for your child to be present and to take the assessment on the designated days. Snacks will be provided for students during the testing sessions.

In early January several parents and their children attended Kindergarten Showcase in preparation for the start of their children's K-12 educational journey. It was a great success; however, if you did not have the opportunity to attend, we will hold a second Showcase Night on Wednesday, April 2nd at 5:30 PM.

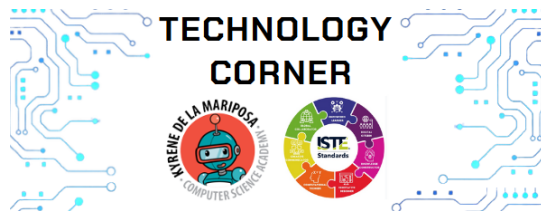

Attention 3rd-5th Grade Families

As we approach our AASA (Arizona Academic Standards Assessment) test window for third, fourth and fifth grades, there are some things families can do to help kids. The Arizona Department of Education says, "Talk with your child about the test—your conversations can help minimize any fear or anxiety your child may feel when taking the test this spring. You can also take practice AASA and ACT tests at home to help your child prepare. For AASA, visit the [TestNav portal](#), select Arizona and click on "Mic Check and Sample Tests". Practice ACT tests are also available through [TestNav](#).

Here are some tips and reminders to help your students come to school prepared for success:

- Start well rested - make sure your students stick to their bedtimes and come to school refreshed.
- Have a healthy breakfast - whether it be school breakfast or something at home, make sure your students start their morning with a satisfying meal
- Arrive to school on time - we want all students to have every opportunity to complete their test to the best of their ability; providing them with the time they need is essential
- Schedule appointments on non-test days and/or after school hours. Our test times will be as follows:

March 31 and April 1: 5th grade only, AZSci

April 3: 3rd-5th, AASA Writing

April 4: 3rd grade only, AASA Oral Reading Fluency

April 8 and April 10: 3rd-5th, AASA Reading

April 15 and April 17: 3rd-5th, AASA Math
